- **CAPITOL DAY:** Each year, members of Partners for Stennis travel to the Mississippi State Capitol in Jackson to increase awareness about space, earth, and ocean programs with our state lawmakers.
- **CITIZENS FOR SPACE EXPLORATION / DC FLY-IN:** Partners for Stennis is a founding member of Citizens for Space Exploration, a multi-state organization comprised of U.S. taxpayers who support America's investment in human space exploration. Annually, we visit Capitol Hill in Washington D.C. to meet with members of Congress in support of NASA and to promote awareness of the benefits of human space exploration.
