Capitol Day: Annually, Partners travels to the MS Capitol during the first quarter of the year to support NASA through exhibits in the Rotunda at the Capitol. Each the event is generally held in March from 7:30am – 11:30am. There may be a reception the night before for travelers and members of the Gulf Coast Legislative Delegation as possible.

Center Director's Community Briefing: Held annually in May at INFINITY Science Center. Doors open at 7:30am with the program starting at 8am until 9:30am. There will be a grab-n-go breakfast provided to all attendees. There is no fee to attend but sponsorships with reserved seating and outreach benefits are offered below:
